Earlier this year in June, Dr. Joseph Nadeau agreed to be the Conductor of the next performance and the Ambassadors from the Heartland Men's Chorus agreed to be the male part of the

Requiem Chorus. Also in June we got our first overseas member.

September 2007 – At the end of August, we found out we had been administratively dissolved by the Missouri Secretary of State's Office because we had not filed our Annual Report. Since this was news to us, we investigated to find out what we needed to do to get reinstated – File Annual Reports for 2006 and 2007. To do this we needed to tell them our Board of Directors for those years. That meant putting together a Board for 2007.

Mission accomplished – By the end of September we had a new Board of Directors – Cheryl A. Bruner, Chairman; Dr. Pamela Stuerke, Financial Advisor; J. Eugene Balloun and Yvonne D. Miller, Board Members.

By the end of September, we had filed our annual reports for 2006 and 2007 and been reinstated.

October 2007 – Battered Souls Advocates became Artistic Advocates for Healing as well as changed the purpose of the charity to what we've stood for all along. A Conflict of Interest Policy and By-Laws were passed.

By the end of October, the Kansas City Women's Chorus had voted to be the female half of the Requiem Chorus and we filed our 501(c)(3) paperwork.

November 2007 receive letter from the IRS acknowledging our application for 501(c)(3) status. We also started partnership conversation with Rose Brooks Center to become the first Partnership Spoke on our wheel and our new brochure is ready for the public.
